

BCM @ JMU 2017-2018 Official Parking Policy

- Active BCM members are given priority in purchasing a parking permit. Note: An “active BCM member” is someone who attends at least two (2) events each month throughout the academic year. Other individuals who wish to receive a parking pass will be given consideration if spaces are available.
- A current BCM parking permit is required to park in the BCM Center parking lot during the week. Parking permits are NOT required during a BCM event, worship times, praise band rehearsals or Family Group meetings. Parking permits are NOT required on weekends for active BCM members.
- All parking pass holders must register their car with the collegiate minister on the master parking list with their car make, model, license plate, email address, and phone number to ensure that their car is not towed. **Parking passes are \$100/year and are discounted to \$50/year for active BCM members. Parking permits are valid from August 1, 2017 – July 31, 2018.**
- Any car parked in our parking lot without a parking permit may be issued one (1) written warning issued by the BCM Campus Minister. The date of the warning and the license plate will be recorded on the parking form in the Campus Minister’s office.
- Cars are allowed one (1) warning. After said warning, if a car parks illegally in our lot a second time, this car will be towed at the discretion of the Campus Minister. Any leadership team member believing a car has already received a warning and should be towed *must* contact the Campus Minister who authorizes any towing procedure. BCM uses K.A.R. Towing services who may be contacted at the following number: 540-564-0131.
- Visitor parking permits are available for guests on a temporary basis. Please contact the Campus Minister to obtain one. As we have limited parking, please request these permits only for temporary situations where a non-member needs to park their car in the BCM Center parking lot other than during any worship meeting time. Visitor parking permits will be issued for one (1) to three (3) day parking privileges.
- Ultimately, the BCM Center parking lot is officially reserved parking 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. No one except the Campus Minister has permission to grant special parking requests. The Campus Minister reserves the right to tow a vehicle without a warning notice if it is blocking access to the center, if there are an excessive number of unauthorized vehicles present preventing members use of the parking lot, or if otherwise deemed necessary for the effective and efficient operation of a BCM-sponsored event.
- The Baptist General Association of Virginia and the BCM at JMU are not liable for any damage done to your vehicle while parked in our lot.

I have read this parking policy and understand the regulations that have been set forth by the BCM Center and the Baptist General Association of Virginia. I agree to follow these policies to the best of my ability and I will not hold the BCM Center, the BCM nor the Baptist General Association of Virginia or any of their representatives responsible for any damage done to my car while parked at the center.
